[Pixley](#), a next-gen SaaS platform for digital asset operations, has launched with full integration into Hathor Network, bringing stablecoin payments to physical retail points. Yep, on-chain shopping is now a thing. Their crypto-enabled POS terminals let merchants accept stablecoins like it's just another card swipe, except it's faster, cheaper, and built for scale. No gas, no friction, all Hathor.

Pixley's stack includes wallet management, secure custody, real-time risk monitoring, and Stablecoin-as-a-Service, which are everything fintechs and enterprises need to thrive in Web3. Why Hathor?
